Here are Safety Tips

- Never leave a child in the car unattended. Rolling down the windows or parking in shade does little to lower the temperature inside a car.
- Be sure to check your whole vehicle, especially the back seat, before locking your doors and walking away.
- Talk to your childcare provider so they call if your child does not show up as expected.
- Use physical reminders, such as shoes, purses, or notes, in the back or passenger seat to remind you that a child is in the car with you.

 Keep your keys away from children and remind them that the car is not a play area.
